DISCUSSION:

MIGRATION TO SWAN, MAGIC DISSOLUTION:

Process started over two years ago. The MAGIC consortium consisting of 14 libraries was not sustainable long term. It is dependent on state funding and subsidized by RAILS. SWAN approached about a merger. SWAN also receives subsidy from RAILS but is economically viable without it. SWAN consists of 97 libraries and it is the second largest library consortium after New York City libraries. This merge with take the library collection from 790,000 to 9.5 million available items.

With this merge the text alert service Shoutbomb will be going away, as it won't be able to support the amount of libraries or materials.

Technical Services will be down starting April 17. Department will be unable to do any ordering until May1 2018. Circulation will be down for three days from April 28 until April 30, 2018. Department will not process any new materials, holds, or fines during this period.
