ROOFING REPAIR UPDATE:

Squirrels chewed through. Support beam is rotted out. Special scaffolding needed to repair.

QUOTE FOR DRAINAGE ON BACK PATIO:

Drainmasters did the front in the past. Formal quote not complete yet, but not to exceed \$6000.00 to put in drains tubes. Tubes will run through walkway so as not to disturb plants.

SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT- LATE JULY\ EARLY AUGUST:

Forms for permit submitted for five feet wide expansion to Blackhawk. District 2 will cover about \$10,000.00 and the library will cover \$7,500.00. Project will begin in late July or early August.

STAFF\TRUSTEE SHIRTS:

Polo's -Sieffert brought sample polo and pullover shirts that will be available to trustees and staff for \$20.00/\$30.00 respectively.

TRUSTEE IPADS:

Trustees will receive iPads for receiving board minuets. Library received 10% government discount. Devices will be property of the library and will be setup as institutional. Trustees will sign form upon receipt and return when term ends. Sieffert will explore procedure for trustees to purchase iPads at end of term.

OLD SECOND\FIFTH THIRD UPDATE:

MB Financial is becoming Fifth Third in the coming year. An ACH account is set up so the library can transfer funds as needed.

Sieffert spoke with a representative at Old Second, looking for better rates in reserve Money Market account.

APPOINT SECRETARY'S AUDIT COMMITTEE:

Zalewski and Quinn were appointed. Trustees will arrive 30 min early for the July meeting.

AFFILIATIONS:

BIG- Diamond sent email addressing her concerns about the BIG group not meeting per the bylaws. Suggested that group should consider disbanding or modifying bylaws to stay in compliance. Sieffert said he will discuss with BIG Administrators to gauge interest.
