SEED LIBRARY UPDATE:

This will launch on April 29, 2019.

Patrons may also checkout a watering can, trowel and gloves.

EGIS SECURITY GUARD THROUGH BSD 2 GRANT:

Through Bensenville School District 2's 21st Century Grant, the District has allocated some of the awarded funds to be used for a security guard after-school to patrol the library grounds. The guard will be on library premises Monday through Friday from 2:30-5:00pm. The library will pay the invoices and District 2 will reimburse.
