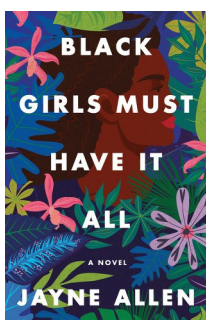


## *Coronation Year*

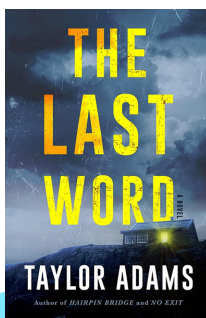


## *If We're Being Honest*

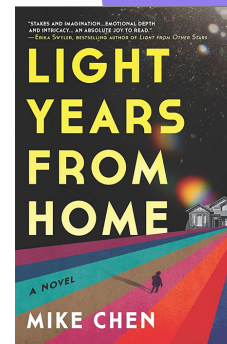

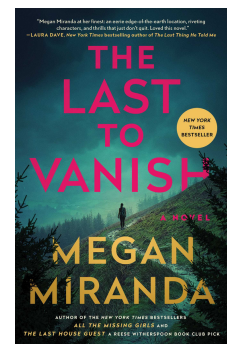


## *The Last to Vanish*
