Three full terms open and three candidates running for those spots. One unexpired 4-year term did not have anyone run to fill it. It will need someone appointed. So, it will be appointed but is only a two-year term until next consolidated election.

Bollard Project

Initial concern that due to a patron driving up on the sidewalk to the library doors, the new replacement bollards would be heavy- duty able to stop a car. However, due to needs of equipment to replace, it will incur additional unexpected cost. Sloan still researching affordable options.

Community Garden Update

Everything is currently on schedule.

Probably have about 10 beds currently and there will be 40 beds total. Soil will be delivered all at once in early April.

More grant funded spots have been filled than the community paid plots.
