Happiness & Love

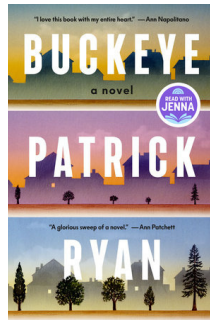

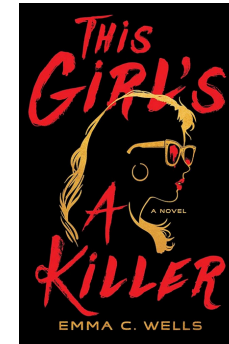

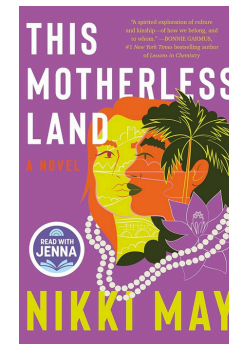
